**DMCI Holdings sustains P4.9B Q1 earnings amid mixed market conditions,
declares P4.0B in cash dividends**

Diversified engineering conglomerate DMCI Holdings, Inc. (PSE: DMC) reported consolidated net income of P 4.9 billion in the first quarter of 2026, a modest 2% decline from P 5.0 billion in the same period last year.

Stronger contributions from the real estate, nickel mining, off-grid power, and cement businesses largely offset weaker results from the integrated energy segment and lower effective contribution from Maynilad.

“Our diversified portfolio continued to provide stability despite uneven market conditions,” said DMCI Holdings Chairman and President Isidro A. Consunji. “While some businesses are facing near-term pressures, we continue to see encouraging performance from our business units.”

Earnings Contribution Breakdown

Semirara Mining and Power Corporation remained the Group’s largest earnings driver with P2.2 billion, down 13% from P2.5 billion last year, mainly due to weaker plant performance and lower coal shipments.

DMCI Homes generated P1.3 billion, up 3% from P1.2 billion, supported by stronger residential revenues driven by lower cancellations and higher rental income.

Associate **Maynilad** delivered P714 million, down 23% from P926 million, as lower effective ownership post-IPO overshadowed improved operating performance.

DMCI Mining posted P440 million, up 8% from P409 million, driven by higher shipment volumes following the commercial operations of the Long Point mine in March 2026, which increased the company’s active mines from two to three.

DMCI Power increased its contribution by 12% to P302 million, from P270 million, supported by higher energy sales and capacity expansions in Palawan, Antique and Masbate over the past year.

Meanwhile, **D.M. Consunji, Inc.** recorded P 47 million, down 6% from P50 million, due to project delays and fewer ongoing projects.

Concreat Holdings Philippines significantly narrowed its net loss by 63% to P203 million, from P546 million last year, following its first full year under DMCI management, driven by higher sales volumes and improving operating efficiencies.

Dividend Declaration

The Board of Directors, in its meeting held today, declared regular cash dividends of Php 0.30 per share, representing a total payout of approximately Php 4.0 billion.

The declared dividends are equivalent to 27% of the company's 2025 core net income of Php 14.9 billion, in line with the company's policy of distributing at least 25% of the previous year's core earnings.

The Board will continue to balance shareholder returns with the Group's funding requirements and growth opportunities.

Shareholders on record as of May 21, 2026 will be entitled to receive the cash dividends. The ex-dividend date is May 20, 2026, while payment is scheduled for June 5, 2026.

About DMCI Holdings

DMCI Holdings (PSE ticker: DMC) is the only publicly listed Philippine conglomerate with construction and engineering as its core competency.

Since its initial public offering in 1995, the company has strategically expanded into real estate, mining, power, water distribution, and cement. Its subsidiaries and associates are key players in industries vital to national development. With a focus on nation building, DMCI Holdings invests exclusively in the Philippines, with most of its operations located outside Metro Manila.
