This is to inform the investing public that the Corporation's power subsidiary, DMCI Power Corporation (DMCI Power) was declared as the lone qualified bidder for the construction, operation and maintenance of a 15MW Bunker-Fired Diesel Power Plant in Calapan, Oriental Mindoro by the Oriental Mindoro Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ORMECO) in a Competitive Selection Process (CSP) held last June 28, 2013.

SUBJECT: Competitive Selection Process for the Supply of Power in Oriental Mindoro

GREETINGS!

The ORIENTAL MINDORO ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. (ORMECO) launched a Competitive Selection Process (CSP) last 28 June 2013, for the construction, operation and maintenance of a 15MW Bunker-Fired Diesel Power Plant in Calapan, Oriental Mindoro, with the end in view of providing reliable and sustainable power supply in the Province.

DMCI Power Corporation was declared as the lone qualified bidder, subject to the results of the post-qualification evaluation. ORMECO shall award the construction, operation and maintenance of the 15MW Bunker-Fired Diesel Power Plant, and the corresponding Electricity Supply Contract (ESA), after the post-qualification evaluation.


Presided over by the ORMECO Special Bids and Awards Committee (SBAC), headed by Mrs. Luzmin D. Biason, Chairperson, and the Technical Working Group (TWG) led by ORMECO Counsel Atty. Gregorio Bobos, the Bidding was participated in by three (3) Bidders, in the following order of tender documents checklisting: (a) Sta. Clara Power Corporation; (b) DMCI Power Corporation; and (c) Mindoro Grid Corporation.

Sta. Clara Power Corporation and Mindoro Grid Corporation were disqualified for deficiencies in their respective bid documentary submissions, leaving DMCI Power Corporation as the lone qualified bidder. Sta. Clara Power Corporation and Mindoro Grid Corporation respectively moved for reconsideration of their disqualification. The parties were directed to submit separate Position Papers formalizing their objections and motions.

Notwithstanding, the SBAC proceeded to open the second envelope containing the Commercial Bid Form of DMCI Power Corporation, being the lone qualified bidder.

We shall apprise you of developments as they arise, for purposes of PSE disclosures.
